I am excited to share with you a new small group opportunity as we anticipate the beginning of the Lenten season. As we come to the "Healing Waters" and engage our theme for this Lent, I want to invite you to a special opportunity to go deeper and explore spiritual practices.

The small group will be called, "Deep Dive: Exploring Everyday Spiritual Practices." This group is for you if you find yourself hearing the Gospel on Sunday morning and wondering how you can integrate it into your life as you go about your week. Or, it's for you if you are longing for spiritual practices that ground you in your everyday life. This is a great opportunity for you if you are new to the congregation and looking for a place to connect. This is also for you if you have been a member of Bethlehem for a long time, but are looking to deepen relationships with others. Deep Dive is an opportunity to learn something new, connect with others, and practice new ways of being and living out our faith.


