


If you are struggling with grief, whether new loss or loss from years prior, we invite you to a new Grief Group starting in January here at Bethlehem Lutheran Church.

For your benefit, we strongly encourage you to attend all 6 sessions, but, if you have a conflict, please come to the other sessions anyway! This group is for you if you have lost a loved one, especially within the last year, or, if you are processing a loss from years ago. This is for you if you are longing for a safe place to explore your feelings rather than a quick-fix or advice. This is for you if you want to learn what grief really is and what it is not and if you want to find some companions to journey with you. This is for you if the holiday season was especially hard this year. This is for you if you feel "emotional" a lot of the time, but don't really understand yourself, your feelings, and what makes you do what you do. This is for you if you have been wanting support for awhile now, but feel more comfortable in a group setting versus one-to-one.

Also, let me know if you might be interested in future groups. As always, please call the church office or email me if you would like a pastoral conversation for any reason.




