This year: Create, distribute, and process a Time and Talent Survey for all involved at BLC Next year: Grow our giving of both our time and our money

This year: Form a committee to explore ideas for Sunday School, Confirmation & Adult Ed Long term: Develop deeper community for youth and families

This June begins a new season in our church year. During the Sundays after Pentecost we experience what is called Ordinary Time in the liturgical calendar. I always appreciated this designation because many of my days feel quite ordinary, shaped more by mundane activities than by milestones. Our days follow a certain rhythm of repetition of all the things that demand our labor, attention, and care.

I want to invite you this Ordinary Time to embrace all that is simple and seemingly insignificant in your daily life. I encourage you to slow down and take that moment to get outside and notice God's presence in the trees, the wildlife, and the sounds of birds chirping. I invite you to take that deep breath when you feel the weight of anxiety or worry on your chest and allow yourself to release it. I encourage you to call that friend when you need someone to listen. I invite you to look for glimpses of God's love showing up *for you* in the most personal way when you are taking care of everyone else. We might just see that what seems ordinary is actually quite holy because of God's extraordinary love.

In honor of this ordinary season, I want to share with you a blessing called, "For this Ordinary Day". It is written by Kate Bowler and Jessica Richie in their new book of blessings, *The Lives We Actually Have*.


